RULES/RESTRICTIONS

No one under the age of 21 will be permitted to enter. No outside food or drink will be permitted into event. No pets will be permitted, service animals allowed.

WEATHER

This event will take place in a heated, enclosed tent in Kelsey-Hutchinson Founders Park. This event is rain or shine.

PARKING

There is NO GUEST PARKING in the park. Please consider walking from hotels/lodging or carpooling to the park and parking in the numerous parking spots surrounding the area on 4th and 5th street.

RE-ENTRY

Your wristband allows you to come and go as you please to the event. You must have the wristband specific to the Gospel Brunch or Weekender to enter/re-enter. Beverages may not leave the tent.

TICKETING/WRISTBAND FAO

Can tickets be purchased?

The Gospel Brunch is sold out! Passes for other remaining events can be purchased online and can be picked up at the box office starting Nov. 8th at 9am.

Where can I pick up my tickets/wristbands?

The event wristbands can be picked up at the box office beginning Thursday, Nov. 8th at 9am. To pick up your wristband, you must bring a Photo ID and/or ticket confirmation receipt. If your photo ID does not match the name on the ticket, you MUST have the emailed confirmation receipt.

The Box Office is located at 411 N. 4th Street Highlands.

What do I need to get into the event?

You must have a wristband specific to the event or the Weekender. Wristbands must be worn at all times.

What if I lose my wristband?

Do not lose your wristband – these are *not replaceable*. Individuals not wearing a wristband will not be allowed entry, no exceptions. The plastic security lock on the wristband is a one-way lock. Do not play with this lock to tighten the band too much. **No wristbands will be replaced.**

How do I put on my wristband?

- 1. Place wristband around wrist
- 2. Hold two loose ends of band tight
- 3. Move the sliding lock toward your wrist until there is a "two finger" space between the lock and your wrist.
- 4. Keep wristband on until the end of the event and do not play with the sliding lock to keep a comfortable fit.

*Treat your wristband like cash – lost, stolen, tampered with, and/or confiscated wristbands will not be replaced!
