RULES/RESTRICTIONS

No one under the age of 21 will be permitted to participate in the event. Children under the age of 21 will not be permitted into the reception. Service animals are permitted. Sip and Shop is a walking event. Please do not drive your vehicle from store to store. No open containers are allowed outside of the stores. Please finish your wine or dump it in the provided bucket prior to leaving the store.

WEATHER

This event is indoor/outdoor. Please be prepared for forecasted weather. Should major weather arise, all ticket holders will be contacted via email.

PARKING

All guests must park at the designated Festival parking lot or in public spaces. Walking from hotels/lodging is encouraged.

RE-ENTRY

Your wristband allows you to consume the beverages and pairings in each shop and allows you entrance to the Sip and Shop Reception. You may come and go from the reception as long as your wristband is in tack.

TICKETING/WRISTBAND FAQ

Can tickets be purchased?

There are still tickets available for Sip and Shop Friday! Passes for this and other remaining events can be purchased online and picked up at the box office starting Nov. 8th at 9am.

Where can I pick up my tickets/wristbands?

The event wristbands can be picked up at the box office beginning Thursday, November 8th at 9am. To pick up your wristband, you must bring a Photo ID and/or ticket confirmation receipt. If your photo ID does not match the name on the ticket, you MUST have the emailed confirmation receipt.









The Box Office is located at 411 N. 4th Street Highlands.

What do I need to participate in the event?

You must have a wristband specific to the event for this day.
Wristbands must be worn at all times.

What if I lose my wristband?

Do not lose your wristband – these are *not replaceable*. Individuals not wearing a wristband will not be allowed entry, no exceptions. The plastic security lock on the wristband is a one-way lock. Do not play with this lock to tighten the band too much. **No wristbands will be replaced.**

How do I put on my wristband?

- 1. Place wristband around wrist
- 2. Hold two loose ends of band tight
- 3. Move the sliding lock toward your wrist until there is a "two finger" space between the lock and your wrist.
- 4. Keep wristband on until the end of the event and do not play with the sliding lock to keep a comfortable fit.

*Treat your wristband like cash – lost, stolen, tampered with, and/or confiscated wristbands will not be replaced!
