The stroll concludes at Jannie Bean Designs with a reception where those who visited every business will be entered into a drawing to win fabulous prizes from local retailers. RULES/RESTRICTIONS:

No one under the age of 21 will be permitted to taste. Beverages may not leave the businesses. It is illegal to walk on the street with alcohol.



WEATHER:

This event is indoor/outdoor. Please be prepared for forecasted weather. Should major weather arise, all ticket holders will be contacted via email.

PARKING/SHUTTLES:

We encourage you to walk or carpool. You are free to park in any public designated parking spaces in town.

TICKETS/WRISTBANDS:

- **Can tickets be purchased?**

Tickets for Sip and Shop and other remaining events can be purchased online and can be picked up or purchased at the box office starting Nov.9th at 9am.

- **Where do I pick up my tickets/wristbands, wine tasting glass and map/program?**

Tickets were not mailed in advance but the event wristbands can be picked up at the box office beginning Thursday. To pick up your wristband, **you must bring a Photo ID and/or ticket confirmation receipt**. If your photo ID does not match the name on the ticket, you **MUST** have the emailed confirmation receipt.

On Saturday, starting at 11am at the box office, you will also pick up a wine tasting glass and program with a map of the participating retailers and a wine a food pairing list for you to take notes of what food/wines you enjoyed.

The Box Office is located at 155 Wright Square, Main Street, Highlands.

The box office hours are as follows:

Thursday-Saturday 9am – 5pm

Sunday 9am – 12pm

- **What do I need to get into the event?**

You must have a wristband specific to the Sip and Shop Saturday Event. Wristbands must be worn at all times.



- **What if I lose or cut off my wristband?**

Wristbands must be worn at all times. Individuals not wearing a wristband will not be allowed entry, no exceptions. **Do not lose your wristband** – these are not replaceable. The plastic security lock on the wristband is a one- way lock. Do not play with this lock to tighten the band too much. No wristbands will be replaced.

- **How do I put on my wristband?**

Treat your wristband like cash – lost, stolen, tampered with, and/or confiscated wristbands will not be replaced!

1. Place wristband around wrist
2. Hold two loose ends of band tight
3. Move the sliding lock toward your wrist until there is a “two finger” space between the lock and your wrist.
4. Keep wristband on until the end of the event and do not play with the sliding lock to keep a comfortable fit.

RE-ENTRY:

Your wristband allows you to receive wine tastings and food pairing at each of the participating retail locations. You must have the Sip & Shop Saturday wristband to obtain your glass, program and to enter/re-enter the reception.

WHAT TO BRING:

- Government Issued Photo ID
- Wristband
- Cash or credit card for festival merchandise and any store purchases
- Rain gear (we go rain or shine!)

WHAT NOT TO BRING:

- Pets
- Outside food or drink
- Illegal drugs
- Children under the age of 21



FOOD & DRINK:

Small bite selections and wine tastings will be served at each retail shop on the stroll and desserts and champagne at the reception.

WHERE TO PURCHASE WINE AND FOODS:

If you enjoyed the wines and food pairing you experiences along the stroll, you will find these items are available to purchase at Mountain Fresh Grocery located at 521 Main Street.
