RE-ENTRY

Your wristband allows you to come and go as you please to the event. You must have the wristband specific to The Main Event or Weekender to enter/re-enter. Beverages may not leave the event.

TICKETING/WRISTBAND FAQ

How do I get tickets to the event?

The Main Event is sold out.

For ticket holders, all wristbands will be given at the door. You must bring a printed copy of your barcoded ticket. Tickets will be scanned and we will assist you with putting on your wristband. No wristbands will be given without a ticket.

What if I have Weekender Passes?

Weekenders will have a special express lane for ticket scanning and wristbands starting at 11:45am. Once tickets are scanned, we will assist you with your wristband. This wristband must be worn for all events. No replacements will be given, so please leave it on to enjoy all events.

What do I need to get into the event?

You must have a wristband specific to the Grand Tasting or the Weekender. Wristbands must be worn at all times.

What if I lose my wristband?

Do not lose your wristband – these are *not replaceable*. Individuals not wearing a wristband will not be allowed entry, no exceptions. The plastic security lock on the wristband is a one-way lock. Do not play with this lock to tighten the band too much. **No wristbands will be replaced.**

How do I put on my wristband?

- 1. Place wristband around wrist
- 2. Hold two loose ends of band tight
- 3. Move the sliding lock toward your wrist until there is a "two finger" space between the lock and your wrist.
- 4. Keep wristband on until the end of the event and do not play with the sliding lock to keep a comfortable fit.

*Treat your wristband like cash – lost, stolen, tampered with, and/or confiscated wristbands will not be replaced!
