WEATHER

This event will take place at the beautiful Bascom: Center for the Visual Arts. The event will be outdoor but protected by heated tents.

ATTIRE

Mountain Chic, Resort Casual, Comfortable Footwear. This event is held at The Bascom, but the event space will be connected by heated tents. We will have a coat check at the entrance, but please dress for forecasted weather.

SEATING

Upon check-in, a hostess will show you to your seats. We will make best efforts to seat all parties together, and seating will take place first come first serve. We will have a full house, so please allow the hostesses to show you to your designated tables.

PARKING

Unfortunately, **NO GUEST PARKING** at the Bascom for the event. We suggest walking to The Bascom from nearby public parking or carpooling. Entry will happen using the bridge outside of the Bascom or via Oak Street from Franklin Road. Guests are permitted to be dropped off at The Bascom entrance on Oak Street, but the driver must continue on and find parking in surrounding areas. If you are dropping off, please enter from Franklin Road and exit by continuing down Oak Street to create a one-way loop. Please do not drop off at the bridge on Franklin Road or park in lots where businesses are still open, you will be towed. We encourage public parking along Oak, Main, and Spring Streets and then walking over to the event.

RE-ENTRY

This is a VIP Weekender Event ONLY. There will not be any additional tickets released. Guests must have a VIP Weekender or a Shot At Redemption wristband to enter.

RULES/RESTRICTIONS

No one under the age of 21 will be permitted to enter. No outside food or drink will be permitted into event. No pets will be permitted, service animals allowed. We ask that you please drink responsibly! HFW bartenders and wine partners reserve the right to stop serving any person who they feel has consumed too much alcohol. Please have a designated driver for any of the events that you plan to drink alcohol. **Do not drink and drive!**

WHAT NOT TO BRING

Firearms, Pets, Outside food or drink, Chairs, Illegal drugs, Children under the age of 21, Cigarettes or vape pens– this is a non-smoking event.

WHAT DO I NEED TO GET INTO THE EVENT?

You need your QR code from Flicket or a wristband. After receiving your event wristband, you must wear your wristband for the duration of the event. VIP Weekender ticketholders must wear Weekender wristbands for the duration of the festival. We suggest you bring a credit card for merchandise from the band, The Bascom gift shop and ceramics barn, as well as to tip our amazing servers and staff!

TICKETING/WRISTBAND FAQ
