PARKING

ENTRY AND RE-ENTRY

We encourage guests enter through the back entry from the parking lot. You must have a wristband specific to A Generous Pour OR VIP Weekender PLUS to enter. Guests may not leave the building and reenter.

Weekender VIP and Weekender VIP+ ticketholders must wear Weekender wristbands for the duration of the festival.
